Fourth & Hope's mission is to feed, clothe, shelter, and facilitate recovery to those in need and to show the love of Jesus Christ in words and actions. They provide a continuum of care for the hungry and homeless by moving them from the streets to stability in Woodland and Yolo County.

What began in the 1980s as a group of Woodland residents concerned about Woodland's homeless and hungry passing out peanut butter sandwiches and bananas in sack lunches has evolved into various programs to assure that every person has food to eat; a place to sleep; dignity and hope. Their programs address physical and mental health, substance use, employment and income needs, and housing. They operate a 65-bed emergency shelter with a commercial kitchen for hot meals; permanent supportive housing programs; and Walter's House, a 44-bed residential treatment program.
